

# Tournament Rules

This tournament shall follow the general playing rules and the following special rules will govern this tournament.

This tournament is open to all. Registration time will be 30 minutes prior to your start time of **9.30am prompt**. Entries will be available on a first come, first served basis, so please get your entry in early.

A provisional ball must be rolled if any dispute relating to pinfall cannot be resolved immediately. Protests should be made verbally at the time, and must be confirmed in writing within 72 hours of the game in which the infraction occurred.

The Tournament Manager's decision on all matters shall be final, subject to an appeal to the tournament committee. The committee, consisting of Clive Morris, Matt Scotney, Steph Peeters, Bert Peeters and John Lambourne, reserves the right to cancel the tournament should there be insufficient entries.

Entry fees will be non-returnable. However entries may be sold to eligible replacements. All fees must be enclosed with entry form. Please note payments can be made over the phone or via reception with cash. Cheques will not be accepted on the day.

Any bowler arriving late will count his/her scores only from the frame then being bowled. Closing date for entries will be 30 minutes prior to the roll off time. Subject to lane availability.

## **Format:**

Players will bowl six games, changing lanes after each game. The highest total scores scratch/handicap over six games shall qualify for prizes. Bowlers will only be eligible for one prize either scratch or handicap based on their highest finishing position. The stepladder finals, which will be played over one game per round. A maximum of **four bowlers scratch and handicap will qualify for the stepladder finals.**

In the event of a tie the highest last game in the qualifying category scratch/handicap wins. In the event of a further tie the penultimate game will be used and so forth until a winner is found. The top 4 bowlers in each section will play a stepladder final. 4<sup>th</sup> plays 3<sup>rd</sup>, winner plays 2<sup>nd</sup> etc In the event of a tie a 9<sup>th</sup> & 10<sup>th</sup> frame playoff will decide the winner.

**Averages** must be the highest gained over 21 games or more in league or tournament play, sanctioned or unsanctioned. If the entrant has no current league or tournament average, KOTL scores may be used if 21 games or more have been played, otherwise last season's average will be accepted. Handicaps will be based on 80% of 210 with no maximum. Entrants without a qualifying average will enter off scratch. Confirmation of entering average must be provided at the time of registration. Anyone found to have given false average will result in disqualification and forfeit all prize money.

The entry fee for each person will be made up as follows:

£6.90	Lineage
£2.00	Jackpot Fund
£4.00	Pot Games
£12.10	Prize Fund

- 1...Jackpots A & B now have a fund of **£70 each** and contributions from each entry will continue to accumulate until the jackpot has been won.
- 2...Pot games will be split equally scratch/handicap.
- 3...Based on 30 entries the Prize Fund will be split equally paying the top 5 bowlers in each section, a minimum of 1 in 3 bowlers will cash during the tournament. Places paid may vary depending on entries.
- 4...It will be the players responsibility to inform a committee member of a winning claim in the jackpots.
