Rules and Regulations

General Playing and Tournament rules, together with the following special rules.

Bowlers who are not members of the BTBA or fail to provide proof of membership are permitted to bowl providing they sign up for a year's BTBA membership (£25.00). If the membership is subsequently proved 14 days after the conclusion of the tournament the individuals £25 will be returned. BTBA memberships will be checked for validity on the BTBA members listing which can be viewed at btba.org.uk"

1. A provisional ball must be rolled if a dispute relating to pin fall cannot be resolved immediately.

2. Protests must be made within 30 minutes of any infraction occurring and confirmed in writing within 72 hours to the Tournament Manager.
3. The Tournament Manager is **Russell Semple**. He reserves the right to reject any entry and her decision on all matters shall be final, subject to an appeal to the BTBA.
4. Closing date for entries will be 10pm on Sunday 29th September 2019 and all entry fees must be paid in cash on the day. Squads may be reserved by email to the tournament manager, but the entry form **MUST** be received before the closing date.
5. Handicap will be based on 100% of 220 and will be based on a league average in excess of 12 games or your tournament average over 12 games. Proof of entering average must be provided at registration. Freefall and Sting are both acceptable without any differentiation for handicap tournaments. Where a bowler has no average over 12 games he or she may use their latest completed average. Any player with no known average will enter off scratch. Falsification of averages may result in Team disqualification and forfeiture of all prize monies and entry fees. Proof of entering average must be provided at registration.
6. **BTBA Tour Ranking Points will be awarded based on the individuals scratch score** after 6 games
7. In the event of a tie, the team with the highest last game will be awarded the place. If this results in a further tie, the team with the highest penultimate game will be awarded the place
8. The wearing of denim jeans, combat clothing, vests is prohibited.
9. This is a non-smoking event and no alcohol is allowed during the competition.
10. **A senior bowler is a bowler who is aged 50 years of age or above on the 01/01/2019**
