GENERAL RULES

1. This tournament is sanctioned by the B.T.B.A. and the General playing and Tournament rules will govern this event, together with the following special rules.
2. Those who are not members of the B.T.B.A. or fail to provide proof of membership are permitted to bowl providing they sign up for a year's BTBA membership (£21.00). If the membership is subsequently proved 14 days after the conclusion of the tournament the individuals £21 will be returned.
3. A provisional ball must be rolled if a dispute relating to pin fall cannot be resolved immediately.
4. Protests must be made within 30 minutes of any infraction occurring and confirmed in writing within 72 hours to the Tournament Manager.
5. The Tournament Manager reserves the right to reject any entry and his decision on all matters shall be final. Subject to an appeal to the B.T.B.A.
6. **Closing date for entries 10pm 23rd September 2017 and all entry fees must be paid in cash on the day.** Squads may be reserved by email to the tournament manager, but the entry form **MUST** be received before the closing date
7. Handicap will be based on 70% of 220 and will be based on a recreational league average in excess of 21 games or your average from previous BTBA tour events in 2017. Proof of entering average must be provided at registration.

Format for this tournament is very straight forward!!!

It's just 1 round...

All teams will bowl 3 games,

Then there will be a lane re-dress

Then all teams will bowl a further 4 games (7 games in total)

The winning teams will be those with either the highest scratch Pinfall or highest handicap pinfall

(Your team can only win ONE cash prize. So if your team qualifies for a cash prize in the handicap and scratch section you will be awarded whatever the highest cash prize is... So if you finished 3rd in the scratch and 2nd in the handicap – you will win the 2nd placed prize in the handicap, and every team in the scratch will be bumped up a place

** BTBA tour ranking points will be awarded based on the individuals scratch score

8. In the event of a tie teams with the highest last game will be awarded the place. If this results in a further tie, the team with the highest penultimate game will be awarded the place
9. The wearing of denim jeans, combat clothing, vests is prohibited.
10. This is a non-smoking event and no alcohol is allowed during the competition.
11. The tournament director reserves the right to reassess any entered average and to disqualify any individual who deliberately submits a false average, subject to appeal to the B.T.B.A. Any disqualified individual will not be entitled to any reimbursement of entry fees.
